The competency-based (CB) [Western Australia Heavy Vehicle Accreditation \(WAHVA\) auditor certification program](#) has been developed by Exemplar Global in conjunction with WA Main roads, who has the responsibility to oversee the development and management of the program. The program provides recognition for auditors who conduct audits using the Heavy Vehicle accreditation standards in WA Heavy Vehicle Accreditation.
